D. Additional requirements

The Faculty of Media and Communication (Fakultet za medije i komunikacije, FMK) is a private faculty located in Belgrade, Serbia. It was founded in 2006 as a fully autonomous legal entity. The Faculty currently comprises around 1,500 students and around 90 teaching staff. FMK offers B.A., M.A., and Ph.D. study programmes in media and communication (including journalism, public relations, and digital marketing), psychology, the digital arts, social work, political studies, and transdisciplinary humanities and theories of art.

Admission for Erasmus studies at the Faculty of Media and Communication is not automatic. Applicants are asked to submit an application. Submitted applications are evaluated on the basis of the quality of the application, the applicant's academic strength as well as his/her knowledge of English.

by the Ministry of Education of Science of the Republic of Macedonia (part of the Ministry's Register of scientific institutions of the Republic of Macedonia, decision number 30). ISSHS is an accredited graduate school offering MA study programs in policy studies and a smaller number in cultural and gender studies.

Criteria for admission for student mobility are: student's motivation and academic justification to enter a mobility program explained in motivation letter; b) proof of sufficient knowledge of English (minimum B2 level).

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 3 weeks at CEU Budapest and no later than 5 weeks at the University of Nottingham after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Agreements may be terminated with 12 months' notice. Both parties should agree to honour any imbalance of student exchange places up to 12 months after the notice of the termination of the agreement. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
